Civil rights activist and transgender attorney **Mia Yamamoto** is a U.S. Army and Vietnam veteran. Born in an internment camp during WWII, racial injustice has been a familiar topic for Ms. Yamamoto from an early age. Her life-long journey is a story of triumph, for she has constructed her own cultural and gender identities while advocating for racial minority and LGBT groups. An alumna of UCLA Law School, Ms. Yamamoto has been widely recognized. She has been named Criminal Defense Attorney of the Year, honored by the Criminal Courts Bar Association, and is a co-founder of the Multi-Cultural Bar Alliance.
