


# West Los Angeles VA Master Plan


# What is a Master Plan?

- Community-based planning process
- Blueprint for revitalizing physical elements of the campus
- 21<sup>st</sup> Century, state-of-the-art facilities that prioritize Veterans
- Healthcare, housing, recreation, employment, therapeutic, benefit, and memorial services



# Process Timeline

Collect feedback from Veterans, community, and all other stakeholders



**Data Collection and Analysis**

- Hosted 6 Town Halls and 6 Open Houses
- Presented at 40+ community events
- Collected 1,200 survey responses

**Develop and Evaluate Master Plan Goals and Framework**

**45 day public comment period**

**VA incorporates comments and updates Master Plan**





- Amenities



**Zone 4 – Recreational / Connections & Partnerships** includes the following features:

- A Veteran Recreation Center and Park
- Japanese Garden
- Hero's Golf Course
